The Mid and Upper Sacramento Regional Flood Management Plan (RFMP) is a large and complex regional planning effort that will impact future flood control decisions within our regions for years to come. The goal is for the RFMP to be a locally driven plan using local ideas for reducing flood risk within the regions. Given the scale and complexity of the issues at hand, a number of Focus Areas have been identified so as to make it easier for locals to have direct involvement in the parts of the RFMP they care about most.
